

LOGGING IN TO HOME WIFI ON YOUR CHROMEBOOK

1. At the opening screen, connect first to your home internet using your home access password.
2. Once connected to internet, DO NOT CLICK ON A PREVIOUS ACCESS POINT (your photo with username that was saved)... use the drop down next to your name where it has remembered you and ask it to forget you. Start clean. Once you've logged in successfully at home, this should no longer be an issue.
3. Click Add Person at the bottom of the screen.
4. A white box will appear asking for you to sign in to the Chromebook. Just enter your last name and first two initials (in most cases) and @hickoryschools.net is already in place. Make sure it is all lowercase.
5. Carefully enter your password: last name and six digit birthdate, all lowercase.
6. You will get to a screen asking you to pick a cute photo icon. Pick one.
7. Next there will be a blue and white web authentication screen. On this authentication screen, just put in your username and your password. Don't use the whole email, just the front half.
8. Once this is complete, you should be fully logged in and able to get to your google drive and other school class sites. If it does not accept your credentials, ask someone else to type it for you. Login error, in most cases, is due to trying to type too fast and making mistakes (I am guilty of this as well!)
